Gloria Ferrer Blanc de Blanc

From Sonoma, California, Blanc de Blanc is reminiscent of ripe pineapple and toasted biscuit, underscored by a distinctive citrus blossom note. Juicy pear, white chocolate and lemon zest flavors fill the palate, which expand through the wine's vivacious stream of bubbles and firm structure.

Sofia

A California sparkling white wine from Francis Ford Coppola. Blended from the drier pinot blanc and sauvignon blanc grapes as well as 8 percent muscat, which gives it subtle, sweet overtones that may sit more comfortably on the palate.

Sofia Pink Mini Cans

Niebaum-Coppola Winery, wanted to sell its Sofia blanc de blanc sparkling wine -- in a 187 ml serving, just big enough for one drinker's thirst and a neat way to enjoy sparkling wine without opening a full-size bottle- perfect for passing Butler style at a reception!.

Iron Horse Blanc de Blanc

The most elegant and sophisticated of the Iron Horse cuvées, made from 100% Chardonnay in Green Valley, Sonoma, California. It is ethereal - like drinking a cloud. It seems to effervesce away in your mouth and tastes like, among other flavors, a perfectly browned, lightly buttered slice of sourdough toast.

Domaine St. Michelle's Blanc de Blanc

Crafted from premium European grape varieties grown in Washington State's Columbia Valley, Domaine Ste. Michelle's *Blanc de Blanc* is notable for its steely character, enhanced by an appealing toastiness. Its bright acidity and effervescence cleans the palate, while the delicate flavors compliment a wide array of dishes.

Candoni (Prosecco)

Crafted in Italy, Delicate and fruity with a hint of honey, Candoni Prosecco is dry in the mouth with a pleasant acidity that leaves behind a delicious and persistent freshness with a dry, well-balanced taste.

Champagnes~

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label

From France, Clicquot's signature brut non-vintage is loved the world over for its crisp, full flavors. This classically-styled, dry Champagne is a blend of two-thirds black grapes (Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier) for body, balanced with one-third Chardonnay for elegance. Its complex nose of apple, citrus and caramel is followed by full flavors with elegance, crispness and a slightly spicy finish.

Moet and Chandon White Star

Produced in France, White Star is a balanced blend of three wine varieties, revealing a harmonious succession of sensations, a soft maturity, and elegant lines. It is a soft and mature aroma of white fruits, like peaches and pears, and hints of nuts.

Piper – Heidsieck Brut

Piper-Heidsieck cuvée BRUT is an exceptionally well balanced champagne -fresh and lively, with light aromas of citrus fruits and spring flowers, made in France. It brings its own lively, vivacious and exuberant character to dry champagne's traditional elegance and finesse.
